Dear Central Coast communities,

One of the strongest earthquakes ever recorded took place Tuesday night (July 29) off the Russian coast, sparking a tsunami advisory for coastal BC. While the 8.8 magnitude earthquake did cause some large waves, BC's Ministry of Emergency Management and Climate Readiness **stood down the advisory at 6:25 a.m. on Wednesday (July 30),** stating that no coastal zones in BC are at risk.

The FNHA Vancouver Coastal Health Emergency Management Team is reaching out to acknowledge this may have been alarming to communities and community members. We are also reaching out to remind communities that the FNHA Vancouver Coastal (VC) Health Emergency Management (HEM) team is here to support communities through public health emergencies and community crises, such as tsunamis. If you experienced any impacts or would like to talk about tsunami preparedness, please connect with us.
