The Wuikinuxv Fisheries Program is looking to hire crew for the Western Bounty's 2024 halibut season.

Primary Duties: Act as deckhand for Halibut fishery on Western Bounty

Preferred (not required) Qualifications:

- Radio operator's certificate
- SVOP small vessel operator training
- First Aid training
- Marine Emergency Duty training

Preferred Skills/Experience:

- Must will willing to cook when needed and required
- Knot tying
- Fish cutting
- Basic mechanical aptitude
- Reliable
- Punctual
- Experience and/or training in safe operation of small vessels or fishing vessels
- Preferable experience in longlining for halibut
- Must work well as part of a team
- Must be a nonviolent communicator
- Must be able and willing to do all work positions on the boat when required
- Must be able to lift 60 lbs is mandatory
- Must be physically fit to go in the **hold** of the boat
- Must be able to stand for long periods
- Must be able to be out on the boat for a span of 10 days

Position details:

- 2 trips - approximately 10 days each, starting in April - June
- 1-2 trips for food fishing at day rate
- Trips leave from Port Hardy
- Seasonal/ part-time
- Starting pay rate is a standard crew share, or percentage of the catch
- Reports directly to Skipper and the Commercial Fisheries Coordinator
